Chicago Area Municipality Leverages Investment in Emergency Alert Systems, to Web-Enable Ballpark Lighting, Improve Accountability and Reduce Expenses

San Jose, CA, June 7, 2005 -- iControl, Inc. (<http://www.icontrol-inc.com>) announces a new application for its product line of remote wireless controllers. A Chicago-land suburb has selected iControl equipment and services to supply web-enabled lighting automation controllers for its recreational ballparks. The system saves the municipality from late-night personnel obligations and unnecessary utility charges. Lighting status, activity reports and system maintenance are available through the Internet.

Ballpark lighting automation is a joint service of iControl and a local electrical contractor who supplies installation and physical support.
